What is WebEOC?

- A web-based platform for maintaining a common operational picture and situational awareness during an Emergency Operations Center activation.

How is it used?

- It is the method by which Pierce County Emergency Management (PCDEM) manages information flow for our citizens and contract cities into the County EOC.
- It can also be used by PCDEM’s Contract cities for managing information flow in your EOC!

What value would there be to it?

1. If PCDEM’s EOC is activated for an incident in the County, you will be able to monitor the information in the County EOC. This may be valuable for your own city situational awareness or may allow you to identify ways you can support other events happening in the county.
2. If your city EOC is activated for an incident in your city, it will provide a way for you to manage your internal EOC activities while also allowing the County EOC to monitor your activities for county situational awareness and resource prioritization.

What does it cost?

- It is already part of your contract negotiated for providing emergency services by PCDEM.

What do we need to do?

- Sign a Memorandum of Understanding with Pierce County identifying a City Point of Contact(s) who will be trained to maintain your own set of users and administrative tasks.
- Have your POC and others using WebEOC attend a 3-hr training session
 - Sessions to be offered in 2009: July 8 / Aug 11 / Oct 16
