The M/V Christine Anderson Due to Return to Service:

The M/V Christine Anderson will return to service on the Steilacoom, Anderson and Ketron Island runs for the last two runs on Saturday, June 14, 2008. The two runs affected will be the 7:50 p.m. and 9:10 p.m. Steilacoom departure times.

Return to Normal Schedule:

The Christine Anderson will resume regular service the morning of Sunday, June 15, 2008 beginning with the 7:00 a.m. run.

With the return of the Christine Anderson, the scheduled runs for Steilacoom, Anderson and Ketron Island will return to the normal posted schedule.

Return to Normal Fares:

Fares will return to normal beginning Monday, June 16, 2008 with the Christine Anderson returning to regular service.

Temporary Parking in Steilacoom:

The Temporary Parking Passes that were made available to the Anderson and Ketron Island residence on or after Tuesday, June 3, 2008 will expire as of 12:00 noon Monday, June 16, 2008. Passes will no longer be honored for free parking. A parking survey conducted over the last two weeks will assess your current desires to provide additional parking on the Steilacoom side of the ferry operation.

Fourth of July Weekend:

Lafayette Street will be the center of the annual old-fashioned, hometown Independence Day Parade and Street Fair in Steilacoom. There will be many activities in addition to the parade. There will be an additional run added departing Steilacoom at 1:00 p.m. The parade will start immediately after cars are loaded on the extra 1:00 p.m. run. Main Street will be closed all day starting at 6:00 a.m. Cars arriving for the 2:10 p.m. departure will need to park on streets that are not impacted by the parade. After the 2:10 p.m. run the parade road closures will be gone. Signs will be posted at strategic locations to route vehicles around Main Street to the top of the ferry lanes. **PLEASE NOTE: The first part of the parade is all young children (children will be on or near the intersection of Union and Rainier at 1250). Drivers should be alert to this when driving off the ferry at 1250.**

On Memorial Day weekend the Christine Anderson experienced a failure on a major shaft seal on one engine. A temporary fix was approved by the U.S. Coast Guard allowing the vessel to operate with the temporary fix. Several days later the temporary repair failed and the vessel went to Todd Shipyard for repair of the seal and machining of the shaft.

While there, the other shaft was rebuilt along with other ancillary cooling and water distribution pipes.
