6 **ORDINANCE NO. 2007-106**

8 **An Ordinance of the Pierce County Council Adopting the 2008 2013 Sewer**
9 **Improvement Program (SIP), Pursuant to Pierce County Ordinance**
10 **2006 115s, and the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 36.70A.040,**
11 **and 36.70.530, Finding that Each Project Contained in the Program is**
12 **a Public Necessity.**

15 **Whereas**, the Growth Management Act (GMA) required Pierce County to
16 develop, adopt, and implement a Comprehensive Plan, Revised Code of Washington
17 (RCW) 36.70A.040, and
18

19 **Whereas**, pursuant to Chapter 36.70A RCW, on November 29, 1994, the Pierce
20 County Council adopted Ordinance No. 94-82s which enacted the Pierce County
21 Comprehensive Plan, and
22

23 **Whereas**, Ordinance No. 2006-115s provides that the County legislative
24 authority shall annually adopt a revised and extended comprehensive Sewer
25 Improvement Program for the ensuing six calendar years; and

27 **Whereas**, the County Council finds that the County Executive has submitted the
28 "Pierce County Sewer Improvement Program 2008-2013" for review and approval by
29 the County Planning Commission and the County Council; and
30

31 **Whereas**, pursuant to RCW 36.70.530, the Planning Commission, at its
32 August 28, 2007 meeting reviewed and recommended approval of the Program to the
33 County Council; and
34

35 **Whereas**, the County Council, following its consideration of the action of the
36 Planning Commission, and all testimony presented at public hearings, finds that the
37 Program is necessary and required, and should be adopted; **Now Therefore**,

39 **BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Pierce County:**

1 Section 1. The Pierce County Council hereby adopts the "Pierce County Sewer
2 Improvement Program 2008-2013" attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein
3 by reference.

5 Section 2. The Pierce County Council finds that the capital improvement projects
6 set forth in Exhibit A are a public necessity.



13 the adopted 2008 Pierce County Budget.



FINDINGS OF FACT

1. In 2006, the Pierce County Council approved Ordinance No. 2006-115s requiring the Pierce County Sewer Utility, Parks and Recreation, and the Storm Water Divisions, to combine information from their respective sections of the annual Pierce County Budget and the Capital Facilities Plan into three more easily understood improvement program documents, for the Sewer Utility this document is the Sewer Improvement Program (SIP).
2. The SIP summarizes the projects, timing, and costs found in the Capital Facilities Plan and Pierce County Budget.
3. The SIP combines information from its parent documents the Pierce County Budget or Capital Facilities Plan. Should the reader find a discrepancy between the SIP and the Pierce County Budget or Capital Facilities Plan documents, the reader is advised that the dollars for a project are to be from the Pierce County Budget and the listing of projects must coincide with the Capital Facilities Plan.
4. Pursuant to RCW 36.70.520, the Pierce County Planning Commission reviewed the proposed SIP and made recommendation to the County Council approving the SIP as presented on August 28, 2007.
5. Notice of the public hearing before the Pierce County Planning Commission was made on September 12, 2007, in the Eatonville Dispatch, The News Tribune, and the Peninsula Gateway. These notices meet the requirements for providing public notice under RCW 36.70.
