

# Neighborhood Dog Waste Station Program



Is dog waste a problem in your neighborhood?

Pierce County has a free dog waste station for a common area in your neighborhood to clean up the mess!

## To be eligible for a free dog waste station, you must:

- Live in unincorporated Pierce County
- Identify a location in a common space in your neighborhood where there is a dog waste problem, i.e. park, open space, greenbelt, etc.
- Identify a homeowner “sponsor” in your neighborhood that will be responsible for:
  - Installation of the dog waste bag dispenser
  - Refilling dog waste bags
  - Reporting damage or loss of equipment to Pierce County

## Approved dog waste station sponsors will receive:

- Up to two dog waste bag dispensers (depending on neighborhood size)
- Two rolls of dog waste bags per station (additional bag refills are at the sponsor’s expense)
- One dog waste sign per station
