### Random Check of Ballots

On February 13, 2018 the political party observer coordinators requested a random audit of ballots per RCW 29A.60.170(4). They requested a manual count of ballots cast for the Tacoma School District Special Election Proposition No. 2. Our system uses five digital scanners and one central count server. A random batch from each scanner was drawn, hand tallied, and compared to the machine report. All results of the hand tally for the chosen race matched the machine report.
