

DART PHASES

PHASE 1—STABILITY AND SOBRIETY

Length: Approximately 90 days after being accepted into DART.

Requirements:



COURT

- Be honest.
- Attend all hearings.
- Comply with conditions of sentence and probation.
- Clear all bench warrants.

PROBATION

- Be honest.
- Attend all appointments as scheduled.
- Submit to random UA's as directed.
- Sign releases of information.
- Provide a list of medications taken.
- Attend sober support, Courage to Change, or other programs as directed.
- Achieve a minimum of 30 consecutive days clean and sober.

PHASE 2—STABILITY, SOBRIETY AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Length: Approximately 120 days after completion of Phase 1.

Requirements:



COURT

- Be honest.
- Attend all hearings.
- Begin paying/working off fines.

PROBATION

- Work on prosocial activities (employment, education, etc.).
- Attend peer-to-peer support groups (AA, NA or others) as directed.
- Comply with treatment, including random UA's.
- Achieve a minimum of 60 consecutive days clean and sober.

PHASE 3—STABLE HOUSING/EMPLOYMENT/EDUCATION/SOBRIETY

Length: Approximately 180 days after completion of Phases 1 and 2.

Requirements:



- Maintain clean and sober housing.
- Maintain employment, advancing education, or a combination of both.
- Obtain a valid driver license, if eligible.
- Plan for long term abstinence.
- Engage in peer-to-peer activities.
- Complete all treatment conditions.
- Achieve a minimum of 90 consecutive days clean and sober.

GRADUATION FROM DART

Requirements:



- Complete Phases 1, 2, and 3.
- Obtain no new charges for at least 180 days before graduation.
- Pay/work off all fines.
- Achieve a minimum of 120 consecutive days clean and sober.
