The Pierce County Aging & Disability Resource Center is a program that assists residents in finding resources and services:

- 1. We help people find phone numbers and agencies that provide services they need.
- 2. We produce information guides and lists and send them to people who need them (such as low income housing, home care agencies, Alzheimer's resources, etc.).
- 3. We prescreen individuals for case management services and state funded in home care services, and assist people to get these services.
- 4. We give informational talks to groups about services for older adults and individuals of all ages with disabilities throughout Tacoma/Pierce County and supply informational articles for newspapers and newsletters.
