

The Constitution mandates that an apportionment of representatives among the states must be carried out every 10 years.

### 3. The answer is B

Of that 309 million, 100 million lived in just 4 states: California, Texas, Florida, and New York.

### 4. The answer is C

Making it the second-most populous county in Washington behind King County, and the 63rd-most populous in the United States.

### 5. The answer is "True"

This money is allocated to building new schools, homes, businesses, hospitals, and much more.

### 6. The answer is B

On March 12th, 2020, an invitation to fill out the 2020 Census was mailed to every resident in America.

### 7. The answer is B

There are three ways to respond to the census: Online, by phone, or by mail. The 2020 census will be the first census ever that can be completed online.

### 8. The answer is "False"

Filling out the census is required because an accurate count will impact daily life in the United States in many ways.

### 9. The answer is C

"Census Day" has been April 1 since 1930. From 1790 to 1820, it was the first Monday in August. It moved to June in 1830, April 15 in 1910, and January 1 in 1920.

### 10. The answer is A

Census takers will begin visiting homes that haven't responded to the 2020 Census in May to help make sure everyone is counted. They will continue visiting homes through July.
